Jharkhand B.Ed Entrance Exam Results Cancelled

The Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board (JCECEB) cancelled the B.Ed, M.Ed, and B.P.Ed Joint Entrance Competitive Examination 2025 results that were published on July 4, 2025. The board cited unavoidable reasons for this decision and postponed the first round online interviews scheduled for July 7, 2025. Jharkhand Secondary Teacher Recruitment 2025 Applications Open

The Jharkhand Staff Selection Commission (JSSC) opened applications for the Jharkhand Trained Secondary Teacher Combined Competitive Examination 2025 from June 27 to July 27, 2025. The recruitment drive aims to fill 1,373 Secondary Teacher vacancies across the state. Eligible candidates with graduation plus B.Ed/B.Tech/M.Ed qualifications and aged 21-40 years can apply online with application fees of Rs. 100 for general category and Rs. 50 for SC/ST candidates.






